



# Penrith City Archers

## Life Membership

This policy outlines the process for a member to be nominated for life membership. Any financial member of Penrith City Archers may nominate another financial member to be granted Life Membership. The nomination is to be in writing and presented to the Board.

A member must have maintained a membership for more than 20 years and have demonstrated a willingness to grow the club, which can include administrative duties or archery skills.

The Board of Directors upon receipt of Nomination are to confirm the recipients details and prepare a recommendation for the next Annual General Meeting as per the Constitution.

### Constitution "Extract"

#### 5.2 Life Members

- a) The Board may recommend to the annual general meeting that any natural person who has rendered distinguished service to the Club be appointed as a Life Member.
- b) A resolution of the annual general meeting to confer life membership (subject to **clause 5,2 (c)**) on the recommendation of the Board must be a Special Resolution.
- c) A person must accept or reject the Club's resolution to confer life membership in writing. Upon written acceptance, the person's details shall be entered upon the register, and from the time of entry on the Register the person shall be a Life Member.

This Policy recognises that Archery Australia's Membership Database be the Register as described in the Penrith City Archers Constitution dated June 2014.
